Lord Mayor Nuatali Nelmes is the 14th Lord Mayor of Newcastle and has served for seven years, returning for a third consecutive term as the Lord Mayor of Newcastle following a general election held on 4 December 2021. The Lord Mayor is only the second female Lord Mayor of Newcastle after popular 1970s-era mayor Joy Cummings, and she is the youngest Lord Mayor of Newcastle.
